Pearson continues to grow in flight volume and as the amount of airside activities to support this growth is increasing, we continue to investigate ways to improve operations, decrease FOD and reduce airside congestion. Building on the success of current Centralized Waste Disposal Locations (CWDL), the program will be expanding with additional CWDLs at Terminal 1 to further reduce congestion and FOD at the gate areas. UPAK will be establishing the next phase of CWDLs on January 10, 2026, as of 0001L at the following Stand locations:

- 157, 162, 163, 169, 171, 176, 181, 256

We will begin removing Towable Airside Garbage Bins **January 23, 2026**, from the individual Terminal 1 gates that are part of this phase as per the list below:

- Jan 23 – gate 191 to 254
- Jan 30 – gates 160, 162, 164, 166, 168
- Feb 6 – gate 173 to 181
- Feb 13 – gate 151 to 172

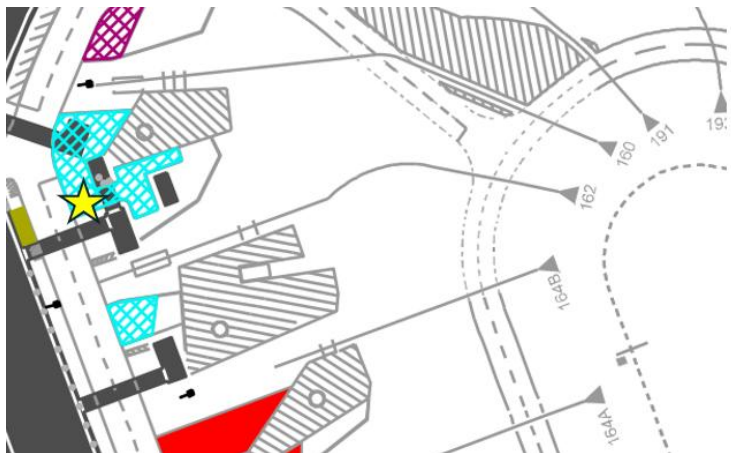
UPAK will be inspecting the units on a daily basis for compliance and adoption of the process to allow time to review the impact to FOD, congestion, garbage, and vehicular traffic in the areas. 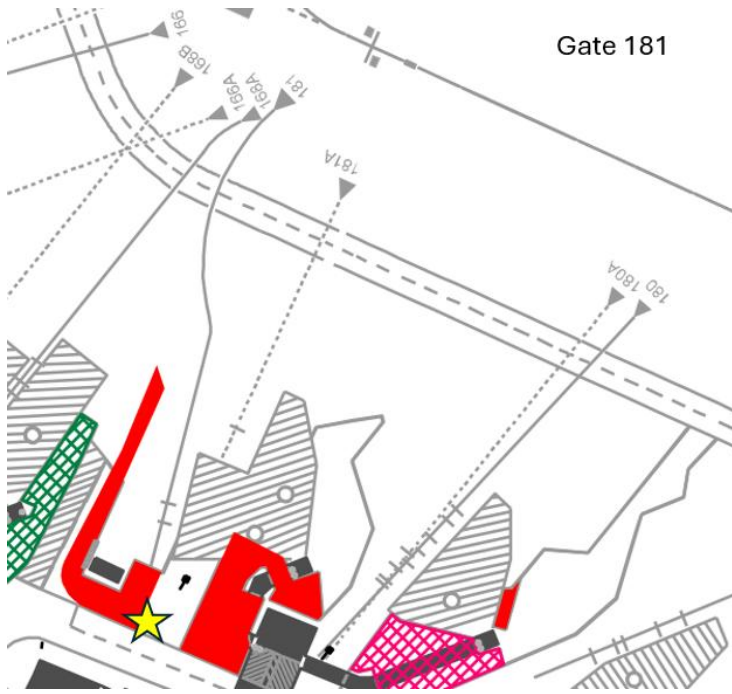

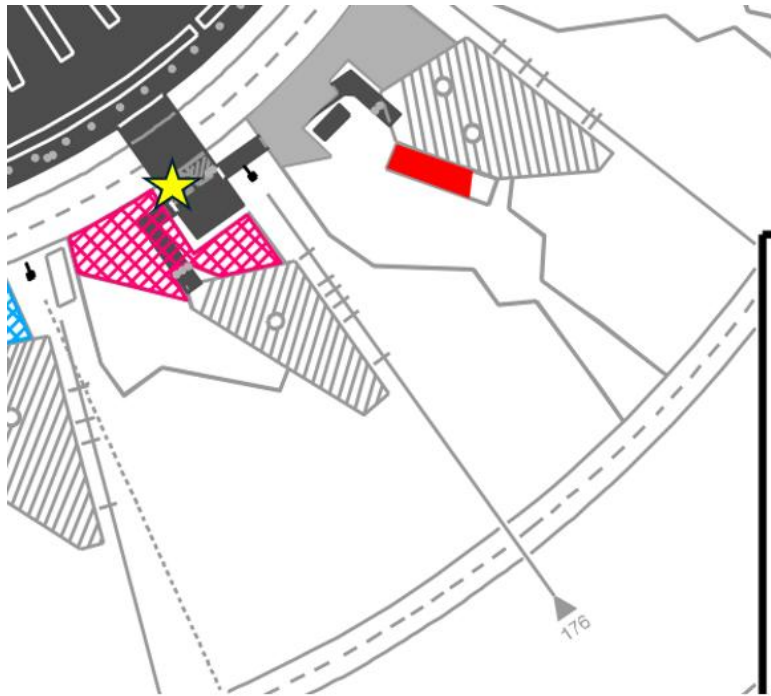
Gate 256

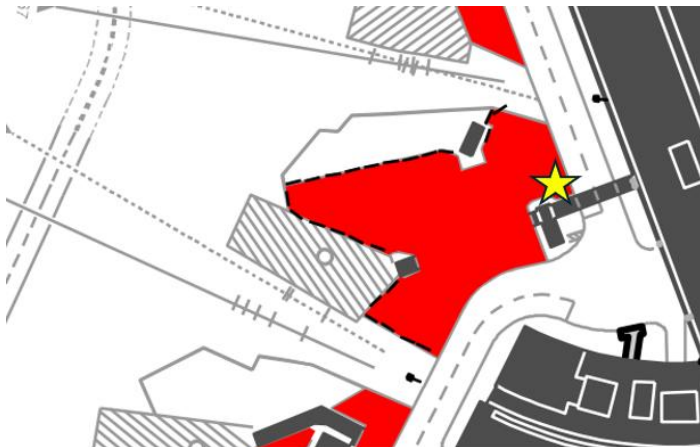

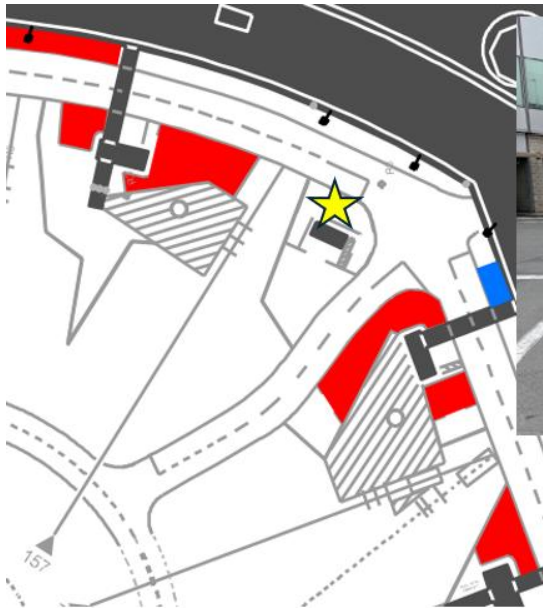
