**Subject: Terminal 3, Substation B, Main 4 Power Shutdown**

To support the LIFT program and ensure backup power resilience in Terminal 3, a power shutdown is required to balance the current electrical loads. To complete this work a shutdown will be performed impacting the following areas:

**When: Monday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 23:00 – Tuesday March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 02:00 (3-hour duration)**

**Where: Terminal 3 mods K & L (Zone 5)**

**What: All normal power will be off for the duration of the shutdown. Emergency lighting will be on in the area.**

Contingencies:

- All employee and passenger screening will be closed at International Zone 5 as of 22:30 and directed to Central screening
- All baggage induction will be halted at the typical baggage belts. All bags remaining to be checked in must be done at OS7 or OS4.
- TBH will assist in moving bags below the wing to ensure all bags inducted at Oversize locations will be sorted to their assigned laterals.
- This same shutdown was performed in December of 2025 to confirm electrical switchover procedures. GTAA operations and maintenance will be onsite for the duration of the shutdown to provide support.
