Subject: Access to Transborder Areas in Terminals 1 and 3

As a result of an increased number of Customs Breaches causing impact to Airport Operations, as well as the continued non-compliance with anti-piggybacking protocols, be advised that effective February 20, 2018 access to the Transborder areas of Terminal 1 and Terminal 3 will be restricted to only those personnel with a direct need and right to be in the area while in the performance of their duties. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions of your Restricted Area Identification Card (RAIC) for additional information:

The Transborder areas of the Terminals are also not to be accessed as a shortcut to other sectors within the Terminal.

Increased vigilance and patrols by GTAA security personnel in coordination with US CBP will continue, in addition to the re-implementation of a zero-tolerance policy for individuals violating these conditions. Anyone observed in contravention of this advisory will have their RAIC seized and will be required to attend an interview along with their employer.
