Subject: New Swing Wall- Pier F Near Lounge F66-F67

Please note an additional swing wall will be constructed north of lounge F66-F67 to provide for two additional lounges/gates with the capability to swing between Transborder and International to more effectively utilize our facilities, and reduce hardstand operations.

The first installation will be a temporary swing wall installed just north of Wahlburgers and Tim Hortons (see photo below). This temporary swing wall will be in place while the permanent swing wall is constructed further up the pier.

Standard procedures will be used to govern the swing of this wall as well as how security sweeps are performed. Additional wayfinding signage will be provided and is scheduled to be installed during the overnight period of June 3-4.

When the swing wall is in the closed position (66-67 in the International sector) a guard will be placed in position at the bypass door **on the south side of the wall only.** This guard will have a list of pre-approved employees that have a defined need and right to transit through the door in delivery of various services. Those not on this list are expected to find other approved methods of transiting between sectors as required.

It is anticipated that this swing wall will be operational commencing June 4, 2018. It is further anticipated that the wall will be swung primarily during the afternoon operation starting at approximately 1400 until the end of the operational day as determined by operational requirements.

Signage at the lounge will be updated to show E and F 66-67. Gate numbering on the apron will not change.

In addition to this, and as a result of this new gate flexibility, the Hammerhead F bus lounge currently identified as E67 for wayfinding purposes, will be changed to E84. This change will happen in correlation with the swing wall on June 4, 2018.
