Subject: 12646 - AJ and Apron Rehabilitation



To accommodate bussing operations at the IFT, the Outer Perimeter Vehicle Corridor at Taxiway AJ will remain open effective immediately until September 17, 2018.

On September 17, rehabilitation work on the concrete slabs within the Outer Perimeter Vehicle Corridor at Taxiway AJ will commence and continue for three weeks. Anticipated completion of work is October 8, 2018. The construction work area is on Taxiway AJ, between the Tail of Stand Corridor and the Outer Perimeter Corridor. As a result of the concrete pavement construction, a full closure of the Outer Perimeter Corridor will be required between the connecting corridor adjacent to Gate B15 and the East Portal of the Infield Tunnel. Traffic travelling eastbound through the Infield Tunnel will be required to turn southbound towards Taxiway AK to access the apron, and vehicles requiring travel between Gate B15 and Taxiway AK will be required to utilize the Tail of Stand Corridor. Only construction vehicles relating to this project will be permitted within the closed area depicted below in pink hatching – all other vehicles will be required to use the Tail of Stand Corridor or take alternate routes.



Flagging and detour signage (per Book 7 of the Ontario Traffic Manual) will be in effect during the vehicle corridor closure.
