The GTAA Airport Development and Construction department is embarking on capital program to improve the reliability of People Moving Devices (PMDs) throughout Toronto Pearson International Airport.

Terminal 3 elevators H24 (passenger elevator to Pyramid level) and freight elevator G17 are scheduled to be removed from service from September 21 until November 22 and December 20 respectively for cab replacement.

Employees requiring access to the pyramid level can take elevators H23, K37 and G18 to the AT level and then take the stairs to the pyramid level. The G17 alternate freight elevators are G20 and H25, both of which have access to the service level.
