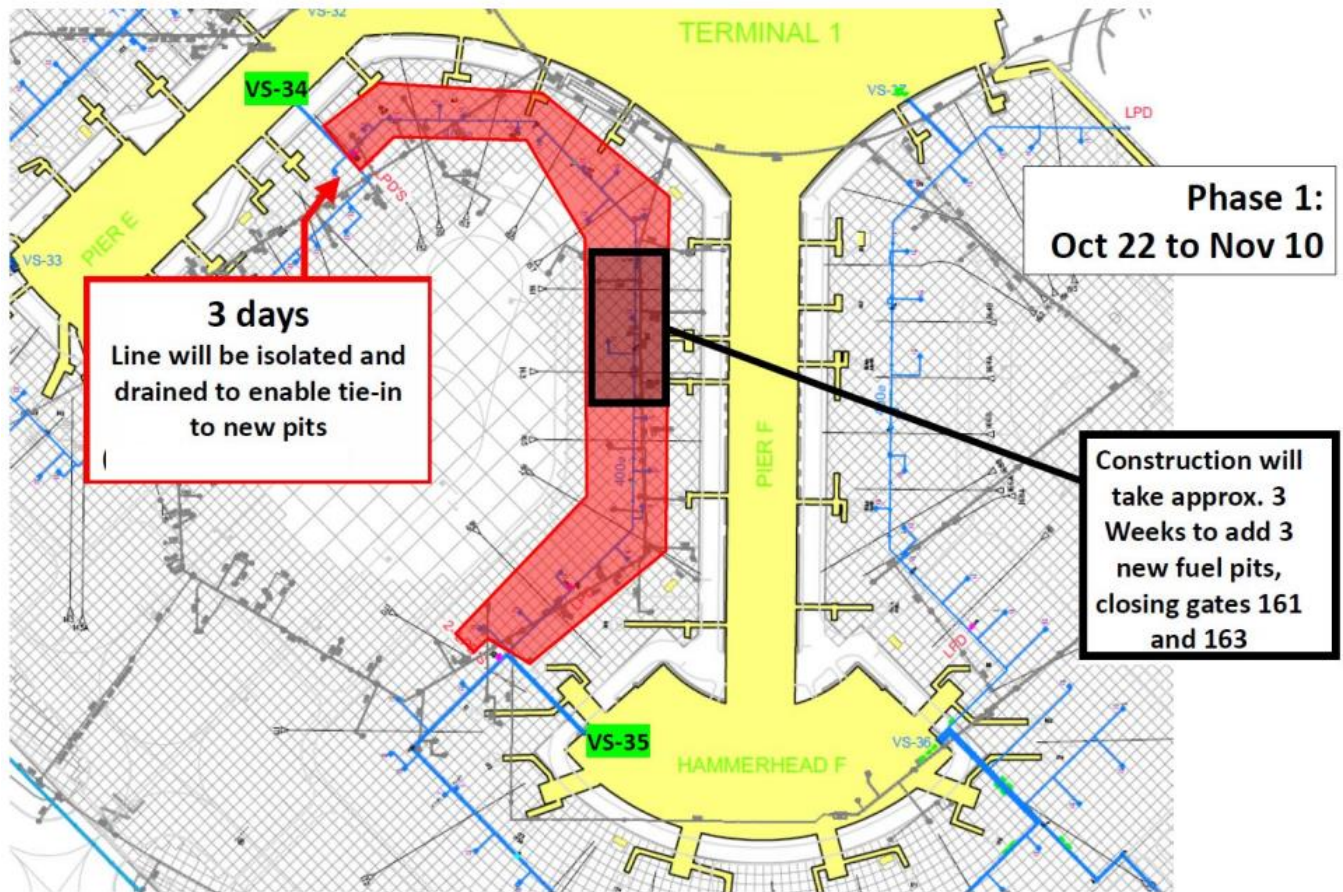
Please be advised construction shall be commencing to provide additional fuel pits for planned gate modifications at gate 161, 163, 162 and 164A.

This advisory outlines the general impacts to the surrounding area for this project being carrying out by FSM. In addition, details have been provided for specific upcoming construction activities that will impact the airlines.

New fuel pits at 161 and 163

October 22, 2018 – Nov 10, 2018

- Gates 161 and 163 will be closed
- Construction fence will be erected at gate 161 and 163
- Adjacent gates will remain operational: 157 and 165
- Between Oct. 31 and Nov. 2, the following gates will not have hydrant fuel and fuel will be provided by tankers: 132 right fuel pit, 151, 153, 155, 157, 161, 163, 165, 167, 169 and 170 left fuel pit
- Gate 138 will be closed for other work and will be used to re-fuel tankers during the outage
