To maintain safety and security and abide by Transport Canada security regulations, the Greater Toronto Airports Authority (GTAA) is advising and reminding all airport tenants and agencies to adhere to the following guidelines with respect to the wearing of Halloween costumes.

Restricted Area Identity Cards (RAIC), as per the Terms and Conditions of Issue, must be displayed in an unobstructed visible location while within the airport restricted area. Facial appearance must not be altered or obstructed in any fashion (masks, theatrical makeup, etc.) so the individual is recognizable with their picture on their identification. Replica or toy weapons are considered prohibited items and should not be brought into airport facilities.
