Information for Companies and Toronto Pearson Airport employees – Cannabis

On October 17, 2018, the Cannabis Act came into effect. The Cannabis Act creates a legal and regulatory framework for controlling the production, distribution, sale and possession of cannabis in Canada and as such has implications for airport users.

Consistent with a number of other major airports across the country, Toronto Pearson has made the decision to prohibit cannabis smoking or vaping anywhere on airport grounds. We will continue to monitor the implementation of cannabis legislation across Canada and evolve our policies as necessary.
