Please be advised construction shall be commencing to provide additional fuel pits for planned gate modifications at gate 162 and 164A.

This advisory outlines the general impacts to the surrounding area for this project being carrying out by FSM. In addition, details have been provided for specific upcoming construction activities that will impact the airlines.

New fuel pits at 162 and 164A

Nov 11 – Dec 7, 2018

- Gates 162 and 164A will be closed
- Construction fence will be erected at gate 162 and 164A
- Adjacent gates will remain operational: 160, 164B and 166
- Between Nov. 21 and Nov. 23, the following gates will not have hydrant fuel and fuel will be provided by tankers: 193, 191, 160, 164B, 166, 166A&B, 168A&B, 181, 181A and 180 right fuel pit
- Newly opened fuel pit by gate 255 will be used to re-fuel tankers during the outage

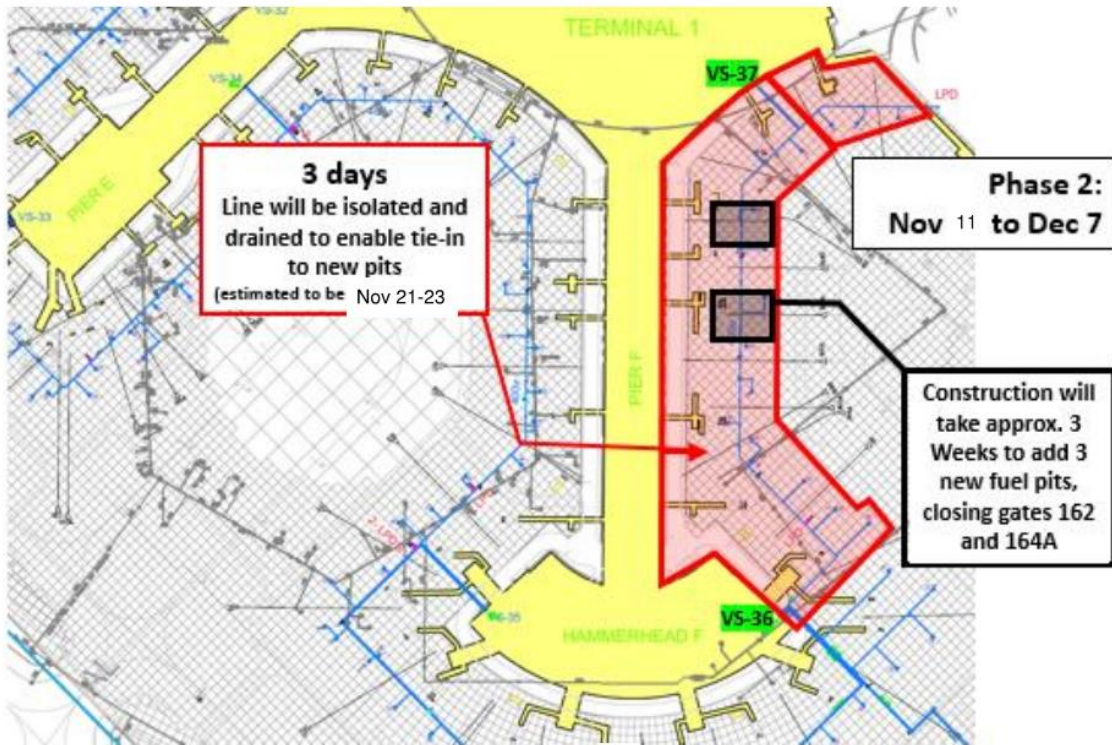


Fig 2. Phase 2: Construction begins on November 11 on East Side of Pier F.
