Between August 17 and August 19, 2019, the following modifications will be made to the Gate 193 East Expansion area and Gate 272:

- 1. Gate 272 will be permanently closed
- 2. Aircraft power out markings permanently removed from Gate 270
- 3. Existing stands numbered 251 and 253 will be relocated west and will now be contact gates.
- 4. Existing stand 255 will be relocated west
- 5. A new north-south vehicle corridor will be painted at the tail of Gates 251 to 255
- 6. Apron lane 11 will be painted and active
- 7. Existing stands 247 and 249 will remain in current location
- 8. Ground servicing, including fueling, is permitted at Gates 251 to 255. Hydrant fueling available at 251 and 253 only.
- 9. Ground mounted PCA (with hose retrieval system), GPU and mobile GPU located adjacent to boarding bridge.
- 10. Potable water cabinet located within building adjacent to bridge rotunda
- 11. Visual Docking Guidance System available at Gates 251 and 253
- 12. New bus bay and bus loop south of Gate 193 Extension holdroom for arriving transborder passengers.

Commencing August 20 operational use of, and access to and from these stands and gates will be as follows until further notice:

- 1. Operational use and access to Gate 247 and 249 remain unchanged
- 2. Gate 251 and 253 as contact gates with ground mounted auxiliary equipment.

- 3. Gate 251, 253 and 255 accessed from Lane 11
- 4. Gate 251, 253, 255 pushed back to Lane 12 tail north
- 5. Aircraft towed forward to Gate 253 before start-up
- 6. Vehicular access to Gate 251, 253, and 255 from new vehicle corridor
- 7. Bus bay access from new vehicle corridor

The layout of the new stands, lane 12 and vehicle corridor are detailed on Figure 1 attached drawing.
