For the 12th consecutive year, Toronto Pearson is using Runway 06R/24L for 2,200 members of our neighbouring communities for the Runway Run. To ensure we keep our community guests safe while on the airfield, we will be restricting access in that area.

Between 0400L and 1400L on Saturday, September 21, there will be no access to:

- Runway 06R/24L
- GTAA Airfield Maintenance Facility (AMF) via the 24L Access Road

There will also be restricted access for through-traffic on the South Service Road between V315C and V315F between 0845L and 0930L. When through-traffic is allowed, all persons must have their RAICs verified again by Access Control Guards after transiting through the area directly in front of the AMF. Delays can be expected, so please plan accordingly and the use of alternative routes is recommended.

The 2019 Runway Run raises money for the <u>Propeller Project</u>, Toronto Pearson's community investment program that supports local neighbourhood-building initiatives that reflect values important to the airport and its employees: supporting new Canadians, promoting environmentalism, and developing young leaders.
