Please be advised that on Monday October 7th, construction will commence to replace the Pier B swing doors. As part of this work, hoarding will be erected on either side of gate B20 and passenger flow will be altered in order to access Gates B17-20 (see drawing below).

Temporary wayfinding signage will be placed on the hoarding directing passengers to B17-20 gates, the domestic baggage hall as well as to gate A20. In addition, there will be a Customer Service Representative located near the hoarding at the connector elevator to assist in directing passengers to gates B17-20.

During the construction period, surreys will not be able to access gates B17-20. As a result, a temporary wheelchair and drop off area will be placed near the hoarding (see drawing below).

Additionally, the domestic passenger corridor will not be available to securely offload domestic flights while gates A/B16-19 are swung Transborder. As a result, there will be an increase in passenger congestion in the A14-15 lounges while domestic arrivals are taking place.
