There has been an increase in pedestrians using terminal access roads, ramps and bridges to access the terminals and surrounding areas. Pedestrian travel in these areas is strictly prohibited for employee and passenger safety.

Regulatory signage has been replaced at terminal exit areas, and new safety signage has been installed on terminal curbs in the following areas:

- T1 Ground Level at East Loading Dock
- Silver Dart and Jetliner

Airport employees can use the following methods to access and leave terminals:

- Come by car – drive yourself, get dropped off, carpool, take a taxi or ride share vehicle
- Take the train – Take UP Express or take the Terminal Link from Viscount
- Use transit – Numerous bus routes access our terminals including TTC, GO Transit, Brampton Transit and Mississauga/Miway

These measures have been put in place in order to provide a safer environment for passengers and employees travelling to and from the terminals, and to ensure safe movement of traffic.
