Effective immediately all current AVOP holders with expiration dates up to and including 30-June-2020, that are attempting to renew their AVOP's will be granted a 90-day extension beyond the expiration date printed on their AVOP. These individuals will be permitted to continue to use their AVOP (D, D/A, GADA) without conflict until further advised.

This amendment will be forwarded to all Vehicle Security Access Guard booth personnel and CATSA NPSV Checkpoints' personnel, to allow AVOP holders that meet the criteria described above to continue through the normal screening process.

New AVOP Applicants

The AVOP Office will continue to make Written Exam sessions available on an 'as required' basis, for 'New' AVOP applicants only requiring administration of a Written Exam. The available Written Exam Session will be Wednesday at 0830 hours and requires advance written confirmation of attendance through your company trainer only.

Should you have a requirement for administration of a Written Exam please contact your company trainer directly to make advance arrangements with the GTAA AVOP Office.
