Beginning on April 16, as part of ongoing redevelopment in Terminal One, there is a requirement to re-route the flow of passengers upon exit from the USCBP Primary Inspection Lanes on Level 3 to the F Gates. The change in flow will take place as the result of the required removal of 1 elevator and the installation of a new escalator. The elevator that will be removed will be closed in behind hoarding and is shown on the attached drawing:

The escalator FDW01 and the adjacent stair will also be closed. **During this phase of work all passengers will be flowing down the west side**.

Additional signage will be in place to direct passengers and employees as needed. Access will be maintained at all times to the west side stairs, escalator, and passenger elevator as well as the elevators servicing the Maple Leaf Lounge on Level 4.

Employee access and egress will be maintained through door FD3247B as it is today- see attached map.
