On April 20, 2020 at 23:59hrs the following changes for airside and critical area access will occur:

1. Two (2) Non-Passenger Screening - Vehicle (NPSV) security checkpoints will close. This closure is temporary and will remain in effect until further advised.

NPSV closing:

- NPSV South-East/PIFFC
- NPSV Infield Tunnel

As per current security regulations and Airside Traffic Directives, prior to entering the Airport Critical Area, vehicles/personnel accessing or entering the Airport Critical Area must report to the nearest active NPSV location.

NPSV Locations remaining active and operational:

- NPSV Cargo West - accessing from the west
- NPSV South – accessing from the south and south/east
- NPSV Northeast/Vista – accessing from the north and north/east

2. Issuance of temporary visitors passes to individuals requesting access through a vehicle gate will only be available from the NPSV South Building. Personnel needing a temporary visitor pass will attend, with their company representative, to the public side of the NPSV South building. This change is to help, encourage and provide an area appropriate for social distancing. Requirements for the issuance of temporary passes remains unchanged.
