**Subject: Flow of International Departing Passengers from Level 3 Domestic Screening to International "E Gates"**

As we continue to right size our terminal facilities in-line with current passenger volumes, effective April 29, 2020 at 23:59, we will be closing the Terminal 1 International Pre-Board Screening (PBS) point. At the start of operations on the morning of April 30, 2020 all International outbound passengers will be directed to Level 3 Domestic Pre-Board Screening (PBS).

In order to facilitate the flow of International passengers from the Level 3 Domestic PBS to the gate areas, a newly constructed connections corridor will be utilized. This corridor will facilitate the flow of passengers from Domestic PBS to Node F to rejoin the existing outbound flow to the International gate areas. See attached drawing below.

The International employee NPS access point (FA3022) will also temporarily close until further notice and employees will be able to access the International gate areas through Level 2 Domestic employee NPS access point (ED2257). From there, employees can join the outbound International passenger corridor to continue to the International departure gate area.

Additionally, a temporary employee egress point has been provisioned in the new corridor for use until the permanent employee egress point is completed. Please note, Employees

must have their RAICs or documents of entitlement properly displayed at times while in this corridor for additional validation purposes.
