On April 27, 2020, with the direction to suspend scheduled passenger flights destined to the United States from Terminal 1, GTAA will be amending the access and exiting process for the T1 US Departure area. As per current requirement all access into the airport restricted area is limited to the employee's need and right to access to perform work related duties. This need and right to access is also applicable to specific areas of the terminal building. Unauthorized access into closed areas of the air terminal building is not permitted and will be monitored for compliance.

Please note that until further notice the Terminal 1 Transborder NPS FD3078A will close on the previously identified date. Employees who are authorized to enter and remain in the closed area for work related duties may access through the Domestic Level 2 NPS ED2257C access point and continue through ED2025C or adjacent doors.

Further, the egress points from this area, FD3078B and FC2070A, will close and egress can occur through the Domestic or International egress point, provided the employee has been authorized to access the Domestic or International areas for this purpose.
