Terminal 3 gate C36 will be restricted until the end of November 2020. This is due to the construction de-mobilization for the Early Baggage Storage project. This restriction will be in place to facilitate a safe aircraft operation around the construction site.

A Threat and Risk assessment was held with the Air Carrier and Ground Handler communities in Q1 and as a result the following mitigations were agreed upon:

- Restrict the gate to Aircraft with two engines – i.e. B747 & A340 types would no longer be allowed.
- Restrict gate to turns of 120mins and more, to allow for adequate servicing times of flights.
- If VDGS is not available arriving aircraft would have to be towed in – having no VDGS also requires wing walkers.
- The gate area cannot be used for parking equipment unless servicing the flight at the gate.
- Ground Handlers will be required to pre-stage equipment prior to an arrival.
- After each flight operation all ground equipment must be cleared from this gate area.
- Ground Handlers are encouraged to call the IOCC at 416-776-3055 to ensure area is clear of equipment prior to flight operations.
