Subject: B14 Ground Power Unit Replacement - Gate Restriction

To support the replacement of Ground Power Unit (GPU) in B14, the B14 gate will have to be closed until January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021. During this time, temporary fencing will be installed around the Passenger Boarding Bridge (PBB) at B14. B14 PBB will be isolated and cannot be operated or accessed for the duration of this time. The following mitigations will be in place:

<u>Times & Dates:</u> Daily 24/7 shutdown from Friday, December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 including weekends.

**Plan:** Fencing is to remain around the bridge to ensure that the bridge is not being accessed or operated for the duration of this work. Only Code C aircraft as defined in the Gate Mix may be parked.

Wingwalkers are required for all tow-on and tow-offs from the stand. At no time shall an aircraft arrive or depart from the stand under its own power.

B14 Gate only to be used to park Code C aircraft. Fencing to remain as outlined in blue below. All Code C aircraft are to be parked on their respective stoplines.
