Subject COVID-19 Arrival Testing

In order to facilitate the recent announcement made by the Provincial Government regarding mandatory Covid-19 testing for International arriving passengers, the following process changes will be implemented on **February 1st, 2021**:

- 1) Effective 1100 local, both the Terminal 1 ITT and Terminal 3 Recheck facilities will be closed until further notice.
- 2) Effective 1200 (noon), all terminating International and Transborder arriving passengers, as well as connecting passengers remaining in Ontario will be directed to the Terminal 1 or Terminal 3 Arrivals Testing locations where passengers will undergo a mandatory COVID test. Passengers connecting outside of Ontario will continue to follow established connection processes until the Federal mandate comes into effect, which is expected mid-February.
- 3) To ensure that connecting passengers make their onward flights, Air Carriers are requested to prioritize the offload of connecting passengers, specifically those connecting within Ontario.
- 4) In the event the Arrivals Testing Facilities reach capacity, established metering / holding protocols will be utilized to ensure public safety.
- 5) Communications regarding pre-registration will be provided shortly to expedite processing and reduce the potential for arrivals holding/metering.
