Effective Thursday May 6, 2021 select Passenger Boarding Bridges (PBB) and associated fixed Pre-Conditioned Air (PCA) and Ground Power Units (GPU) will be shutdown. The Visual Guidance Docking System (VDGS), the lighting in the bridge and the Potable Water Cabinets (PWC) will all remain active. The shutdown work will take place over the next week as communicated at the AOC and AOSC meetings.

The following are the impacted stands:

- Terminal 1 126, 128, 166, 167, 191, 193, 246 to 256 (Pier G)
- Terminal 3 A2-A6 (Pier A), B13 to B19
- Infield Concourse (IFC) 521-530

The Resource Management Unit (RMU) may allocate aircraft parking at these stands where the PBB's and support systems have been deactivated. The bridges will be retracted to their home position with the drive function disabled. The Airline/Ground Handler will be responsible to provide airstairs, GPU and PCA as required.

Our Capacity Planning team will continue to monitor demand for these stands and will provide adequate notice as to when these should be brought back on-line.
