Application of larvicide for mosquito control at Toronto Pearson

From May 31 to October 31, 2021, the GTAA will be conducting a larviciding program under the authority of the Medical Officer of Health to control larval mosquitoes to prevent their development into vectors of West Nile Virus.

The larvicide will be applied to catch basins and may be applied to selected bodies of surface water such as ditches and ponds on Toronto Pearson property depending on the results of testing for the presence of mosquito larvae.

Signs will be posted at surface water locations where larvicide is applied. All larvicides will be applied by The Ministry of Environment, Conservation & Parks licensed applicators or technicians.
