As part of a research study that was supported in part by the National Research Council of Canada, asymptomatic airport workers have been able to access free, rapid COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) testing on-site at Toronto Pearson.

The study, designed to explore the effectiveness of Rapid testing in an airport environment and to compare the efficacy of antigen testing against the polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test, has reached its objectives and will conclude on Friday, July 9 at 16:00.

Employees with have COVID symptoms or who have reason to believe they have been exposed to COVID, should notify your manager and stay home. Contact the local public health unit or health care provider for instructions on accessing a test at a facility in their local area.

Asymptomatic employees who wish to access a PCR test on-site should stay tuned for more details about a new, cost-effective service to launch this summer.
