Subject: Cessation of COVID-19 Temperature Screening at Toronto Pearson

Early last year, Transport Canada implemented the requirement for temperature screening to be conducted by CATSA at passenger and non–passenger screening checkpoints.

The Government of Canada has officially announced that CATSA temperature screening will cease as of August 09, 2021. As such, all CATSA temperature screening processes for passengers and employees at Toronto Pearson will cease no later than 23:59 local time on August 8, 2021. The practice of issuing wristbands will also cease as of the stated time. All passengers and non-passengers **are still required to wear a face mask** while on Airport property, including when going through a security screening checkpoint.

Background and Impact:

Reducing the spread of COVID-19 and keeping each other healthy and safe remains a top priority at Toronto Pearson and requires multiple actions, including staying home if sick, testing and tracing, proper hand and respiratory hygiene, physical distancing and use of face masks for all individuals in all terminal areas. To help maintain a safe airport environment for all, it is incumbent on all of us to follow these practices and to kindly remind passengers and colleagues who may not be applying the rules properly.
