On Saturday, March 26, 2022, from 8:30 to 9:30 p.m. EDT, power will be reduced in many of our facilities, where the safety and comfort of our passengers and employees will allow. The GTAA will inform passengers via social media and [TorontoPearson.com](https://torontoperson.com). We invite all Toronto Pearson tenants to join us during Earth Hour by reducing their power consumption where operationally feasible.

We encourage you to reduce your power usage in administrative areas by turning off non-operational computers, monitors, under cabinet lighting, heaters, and printers, including connected power bars.

Earth Hour continues to be used as a test to identify where Toronto Pearson can achieve new, permanent power reductions in ways that will not affect customer experience.
