**Subject: Apron Stand H4 modifications and Vehicle Corridor Repositioning**

**Objective:** To enable H4 to be operational as a walkout stand, similar to adjacent walkout stands 245A, 245B and 245C. H4 will utilize the existing corridor at gate 245 and will be referred to as gate F99d from inside the terminal for passenger wayfinding and boarding, while maintaining its airside nomenclature as stand H4.

**Facilitation:** Effective July 20, 2022,

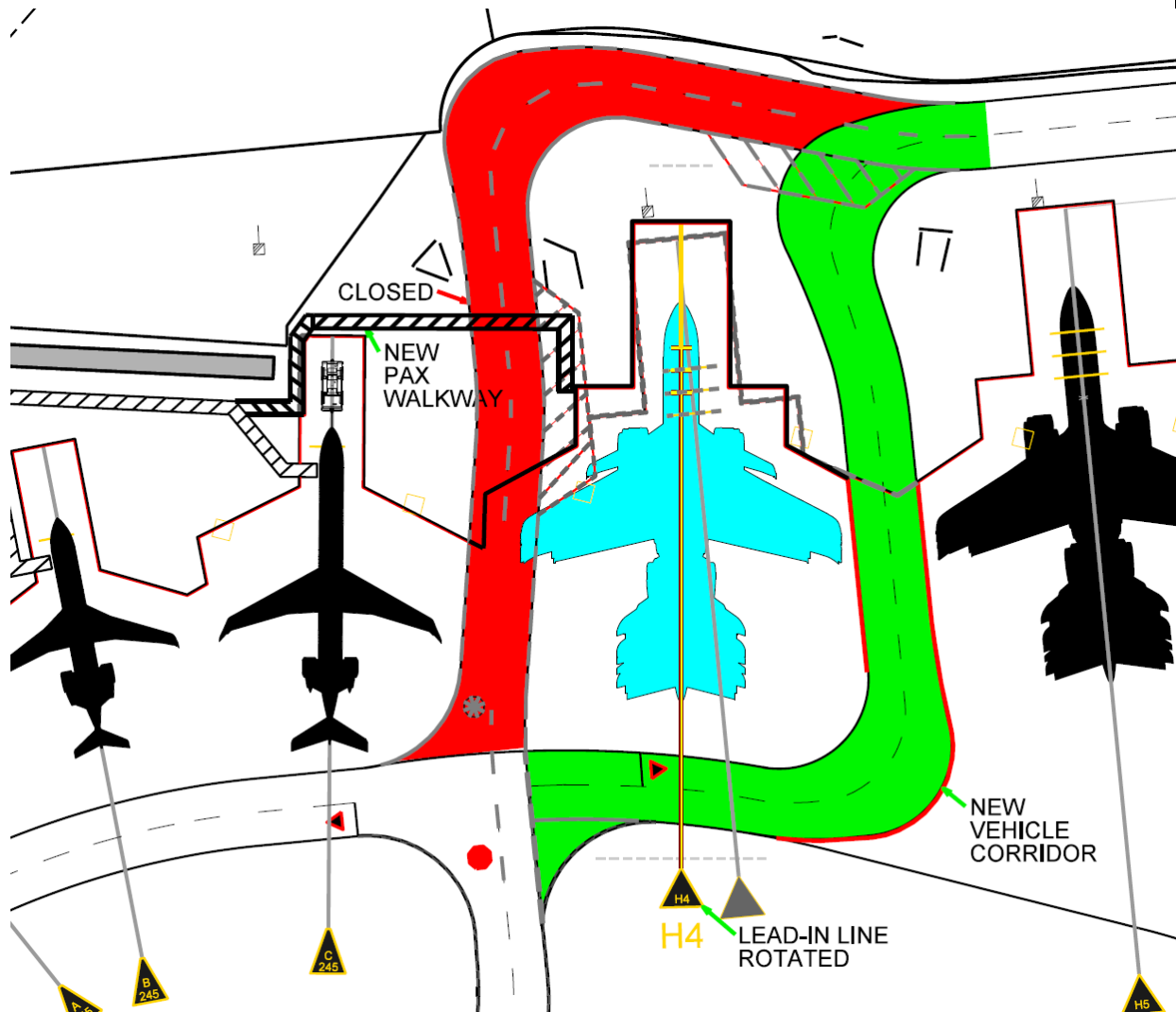
- the vehicle corridor between Stand 245C and Stand H4 will be closed **permanently**.
- The Tail-of-Stand corridor will be extended behind H4 with the corridor transitioning to Head-of-Stand Road between Stands H4 and H5 as depicted.

As a result of the above changes, the following temporary closures and restrictions will be required:

- Stand H4 Closed July 20, 2022 @ 0700-1500L.
- Stand 245C Closed July 20, 202 @ 1000-1300L.
- Vehicle corridors closed between Stand 245C and H5.
- Traffic coming from the connecting corridor at H3 may be redirected towards 245C.

Stand H4 lead-in line will be moved to accommodate the new roadway, and a new passenger walkway will be introduced leading from Stand 245C to H4 to support new passenger operations.

Please be aware of non-standard vehicle and equipment movements near Stand H4 for the duration.
