Subject: Masking Requirements Suspended for All Passengers and Employees

The Government of Canada's COVID-19 border and travel measures will be removed effective October 1, 2022. This includes the removal of the requirement for passengers and employees to wear masks at the airport.

Following an assessment of the health and safety risks currently presented by COVID-19, the GTAA has decided that effective at 00:01, October 1, 2022, until further notice. The mandatory mask requirement in public spaces at Toronto Pearson will be suspended.

Masks are recommended but optional. Passengers and your colleagues may choose to continue to wear masks for various personal reasons, and you are expected to treat them inclusively with respect and dignity.

Directive 2020-D-005 regarding Mandatory Face Coverings and Airport Access Restrictions will be suspended as of October 1, 2022, until further notice.
