As the rehabilitation of Runway 06L/24R nears completion planned name changes will be coming into force for the redesigned holding bays and some associated taxiways. The names are being modified to align with international best-practice where multiple taxilanes enter holding bays and as an incursion-prevention initiative. A NavCanada Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP) is in place for flight operations partners.

06L Holding Bay and Taxiways to 06R


An island is to be introduced, dividing the holding bay into two taxi lanes. Formerly all lanes were named Delta – the new lanes will be named as indicated below – D8 for the west side; D6 for the east side. <u>Implementation Date: Nov 3, 2022</u>

24R Holding Bay

An island is to be introduced in this holding bay as well. Formerly all lanes were named Delta – the new lanes will be named as indicated below – C5 for the west side; C7 for the east side. <u>Implementation Date: Nov 18, 2022</u>
