To continue supporting our airline partners with sterility concerns, we install visual indicators to assist with Directive 2023 - D - 003 - Security Breaches in the Transborder Designated Area.

The GTAA remains committed to aiding and ensuring sterility is maintained during swing operations. As a result, we have installed slide signs in the arrivals corridors at the following gates;

Terminal 1 – Gates 153, 136, 132. The sliding indicator is mounted above the keypad to confirm the lounge configuration.

Terminal 3 - B18, 19. The sliding indicator is mounted beside the keypad to confirm the lounge configuration. Example of Slide Sign:

The red/US Flag indicates lounge is configured to Transborder. Offloading passengers cannot be directed into the lounge.

The green/Canadian Flag indicates Domestic configuration. Domestic arriving passengers can be directed into the lounge.
