
Background: The Ground Operations Manual outlines aircraft maintenance run procedures along with location and time of day restrictions and associated apron safety considerations. This addendum incorporates a new run-up location #20 as described below.

Location #20: This new position is located within RWY 24R Holding Bay between Taxiway C / Taxiway D centerlines (see attached drawings). This location is approved for a maximum Code E aircraft size (i.e. wingspan less than 65m), north-facing only with heading deviation limited to five degrees west and ten degrees east. A nosewheel stop position marking has been added to facilitate aircraft positioning. This position is approved for operations between 0630-1159 local time only.
