Subject: New Advanced Visual Docking Guidance System (A-VDGS)

Expected Action: Operators are required to brief appropriate staff on this Directive and

ensure compliance.

Background and Impact: The purpose of this Directive is to inform operators that the first phase of the Advanced Visual Docking Guidance System (A-VDGS) is now fully operational on the aircraft parking stands on Terminal 1 and 3 (with exception of those stands listed in Table 2). It is a mandatory requirement on operators that the A-VDGS is used on all stands where it is in service.

The new A-VDGS is now operating on the ADB SAFEGATE SafeControl Apron Management (SAM) system software. The Ramp Information Display System (RIDS) on the A-VDGS will display information in the format shown in Table 1, 60 minutes prior to the next arrival or departure.

Please note that the SAM system is also integrated with the Airport-Collaborative Decision Making (A-CDM) System. Operational trials of the A-CDM System are scheduled to start in September, this year. When the A-CDM System is in operation, the RIDS displays will also show information generated by the A-CDM System, where indicated in the Table 1.

Table 2 provides the list of stands where the A-VDGS units are <u>not</u> currently available.

- Use the A-VDGS units on all stands where it is in service; and
- Report any unserviceable A-VDGS unit to Airport Operations at (416) 776-3055 (and GTAA Maintenance will then tag it as out-of-service, pending repair).
