Expected Action: Programmable Logic Controllers (PLC) and OT/ICS (Operational Technology or Industrial Control System) components are typically housed within a physical cabinet; these cabinets must be locked and always secured unless being actively serviced by authorized personnel. If a cabinet is unable to be locked (e.g. Lock missing or broken), contact otcybersecurity@gtaa.com to report the issue. This Directive shall take effect immediately and retroactively for all areas of the existing assets, airport projects and initiatives in development.
