Note:

- Students are not permitted post-security - Health & Safety requirements apply to any student participating in a company sponsored event
- Students must be under the very strict guidance of competent and qualified individuals at all times

- Students may not operate any mechanical, electrical, or powered equipment

If your workplace is not participating in organized and sponsored events, you can take advantage of the **Toronto Pearson's virtual program for Take Our Kids to Work day** sponsored by the GTAA which is open to all Toronto Pearson employees and partners – **there is *no on-site job shadow component pre or post security for this virtual program.***
