

## AIRSIDE SAFETY RODEO CONTEST

### CONTEST RULES

**1. CONTEST PERIOD:** The Airside Safety Rodeo contest (the "Contest") begins at 1100 hrs September 21, 2023 and ends at 1300 hrs on September 21, 2023 (the "Contest Closing Date"). No purchase necessary. Only one (1) entry per person.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:** This Contest is open to all Greater Toronto Airports Authority (the "GTAA") employees and Toronto Pearson Airport workers with a valid RAIC, valid AVOP DA/D Permit and valid PDL which must be in their possession in order to participate. Security Control Pass holders must adhere to the security escort requirements and ensure their escort is present at all times.

**THERE IS A LIMIT OF 20 ENTRANTS FOR EACH CHALLENGE.**

**Participants can only participate in one challenge. The participants must identify their challenge during registration.**

### **3. HOW TO ENTER:**

#### ***Challenge #1 – Parking Challenge***

The challenge consists of driving a vehicle through the path delineated by the cones as part of obstacles course and then reversing into a parking spot. Points will be deducted from the contact with the cones and improper parking. GTAA will provide vehicle for common use for this challenge to be able to participate in the contest

#### ***Challenge #2 – Slalom course***

The challenge consists of driving a baggage tug with 6 baggage carts attached through the path delineated by the cones without knocking any of them down. Points will be deducted from the contact with the cones. GTA D'Nata will provide 6 baggage carts with tractor for common use for this challenge to be able to participate in the contest. Additional space will be allocated onsite to accommodate parking for the participants and their vehicles/ tugs.

Once the participant completes the challenge, they will be provided draw tickets to complete with their contact information and then dropped off in the "box" for the draw at the end of the event. Participants are free to stay and observe or may leave if they choose to do so. The draw will include the draw tickets from both challenges to allow for equal opportunity to win the prize. The winner will be announced after 1300 hrs and if not present, contacted for the award.

Odds of winning depend on the number of Eligible Entries received as of the Contest Closing Date. By entering this Contest, entrants agree to be bound by these Contest Rules and by the decisions of the GTAA, which shall be final on all matters relating to this Contest. The GTAA is not responsible for late, invalid, illegible, incomplete, or misdirected entries. All entries become the property of the GTAA and will not be returned.

### **4. PRIZES:**

**Grand Prize:** Two (2) Economy Class round trip promotional tickets in North America, valid for travel on Air Canada, Air Canada Express and Air Canada Rouge scheduled flights only. Market Value. Travel must be completed by September 23, 2024. Blackout periods apply.

Winner and travelling companion are responsible for ensuring they have the necessary travel documents and the GTAA is not responsible in the event the winner and/or their traveling companion are refused boarding at any time by the airline or airport security and any unused portion of the prize will be forfeit.

In the event any portion of this Contest is compromised by non-authorized human intervention or other causes beyond the control of the GTAA, which, in the sole opinion of the GTAA, corrupts, or impairs the administration, security, fairness or proper submission into the Contest, the GTAA reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to suspend or terminate this Contest. Any entrant found tampering with or undermining the Contest will be disqualified.

**9. TAXABLE BENEFIT:** The Prize awarded to the winning GTAA employee is deemed a taxable benefit pursuant to the Canada Revenue Agency and all applicable taxes shall be paid by the winning GTAA employee.

**10. APPLICABLE LAWS:** This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws.
