	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Seneca Polytechnic – Michael Rotundo</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ This Thursday, September 11, 2025, 17 Seneca students will be graduating from the RAIC Readiness Program. This program allows for a smooth transition from schooling to work at the airport. Our Manager of the Academic Program and our Program Coordinator will be in attendance.</li></ul></li><li>• <b>City of Toronto – Councillor Crisanti</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ The City of Toronto should know soon, when the Finch LRT is going to be greenlighted and up and running as well as the Eglinton Crosstown. There will be two new lines that will help move people into the airport. I am advocating heavily and making good progress. We recently announced at Woodbine Racetrack, a new GO Train station that has been approved and funded. It will be located at the south end of the racetrack around Hwy 27 and Belfield Road. I am advocating to have the Finch LRT extended two kilometers from Humber College to the new GO Train station. There is a lot of development on the Woodbine lands, including 40,000 units of housing. So the need for the GO Train station is there. This City of Toronto is entering a new budget season now which will extend into 2026 and then the election.</li></ul></li></ul>
