Scope of the closure

Aircraft manufacturer Bombardier is relocating its assembly operations from Downsview to Toronto Pearson. To accommodate this work a temporary closure of Runway 05/23 is required to allow access to the site. This closure can be cancelled day of in case of inclement weather. Please note that the closure dates are dependent on weather conditions, and an extension of closure dates is possible.

This is a closure of one of the east/west runways; most traffic will move to one of the other east/west runways, Runway 06L/24R. **This runway is already in regular use, however there may be change to the proportion of traffic.**

When in an easterly operation Runway 06L will be used for arrivals and departures affecting areas to the east and west aligned with this runway. When in a westerly operation Runway 24R will be used for arrivals and departures also affecting areas to the east and west aligned with this runway.

Below is a list of the affected Ridings for the runway operations listed above:

Affected Ridings to the east of the airport: East of airport Etobicoke North, Etobicoke Centre, Humber River Black Creek, York Centre, Willowdale, Don Valley North, Markham-Thornhill, and Markham-Unionville,

Affected Ridings to the west of airport: Mississauga-Malton, Mississauga East-Cooksville, Mississauga-Streetsville, Mississauga-Erin Mills, Mississauga-Centre, and Milton

In some cases, runways 33L or 33R to the north may be used for departures in combination with arrivals on either Runway 06L or Runway 24R.

Additionally, affected Ridings to the north: Brampton East, Brampton Centre, Brampton North, and Mississauga-Malton
