MAINTENANCE NOTICE

The Toronto Pearson Noise Office publishes Maintenance/Construction Notices for resident awareness of airfield maintenance and construction that could lead to increased usage of other runways. This is regular, scheduled maintenance that may consist of but is not limited to grass cutting, rubber removal, patching, electrical work, and line painting. This schedule is subjected to change, and unscheduled runway unavailability may occur.

RUNWAYS IMPACTED

February 15, 2018 from 12:30 am to 6:00 am and 10:30 am to 2:00 pm	05/23 Runway 05/23 is part of our <u>preferential</u> runway system.	Runway lighting testing and updating electrical grid on airfield
February 16 and 20, 2018 from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm	15R/33L	Replacing cable for instrument landing system and electrical work
February 16 to 22, 2018 from 12:30 am to 5:30 am nightly	15L/33R and 06R/24L Runway 15L/33R is part of our preferential runway system.	Crane operating South of the airport, restricting runway operation of impacted runways to 33R departures only
February 20, 2018 from 12:30 am to 6:00 am and 10:30 am to 2:00 pm	06L/24R Runway 06L/24R is part of our preferential runway system.	Runway lighting testing and updating electrical grid on airfield

Our <u>preferential runway system</u> is in effect during the nighttime hours of midnight to 06:30. Maintenance on those runways could mean increased use of other runways while work is underway.
