





Construction Program 2013

- Major projects with a potential noise impact on surrounding areas are:
 - 1. Runway 15L-33R surface maintenance
 - 2. Runway 15R-33L surface maintenance and navigational aides replacement
 - 3. Runway 06L-24R, adjacent taxiways and holding bay areas surface maintenance

Runway 15L-33R

Rehabilitation Work

- During the month of April runway surface maintenance was carried out on the intersection of Runways 15L-33R and 05-23 (One of our busiest intersections)
 - Runway 15L-33R was worked on for re-surfacing, inset lighting and repainting in three phases
 - This was completed on June 7, 2013

The Impacts

- Arrivals on runway 15R and straight out departures on Runway 33L both affect Brampton wards 7, 8, 9 and 10
- Departures on runway 15R, which are rare, affect Mississauga south of the airport (Ward 5) and parts of Toronto's western edge bordering Mississauga



Complaints & Impacts (North/South runways April and May)

- Sustained arrivals for runway 15R were experienced on April 26 and April 28
 - Noise complaints related to arrivals on runway 15R were significant in April
 as the flight path for this runway is directly over a residential area
 - 1 caller accounted for 152 of those noise concerns for arrivals on 15R
- Sustained departures for runway 33L were experienced on April 13-17 and May 16, 20, and 23
 - A total of 12 noise concerns for departures on runway 33L from 9 callers were recorded

Runway 15R-33L

The Work

- Rehabilitation work and navigational aides replacement
- From June 8th to the end of July the Instrument Landing System (ILS) for Runway 15R-33L will be replaced and upgraded
 - An ILS is a ground based precision guidance system using radio signals to guide aircraft for a safe landing
- At the same time, re-surfacing work will be carried out while the runway is unavailable
- Work is underway

Runway 15R-33L

Impacts – 15R


- When weather requires operations to the south, Runway 15R is usually assigned to arrivals, and Runway 15L to departures
 - As Runway 15R will not have a functioning ILS it will not be assigned to arrivals
 - Runway 15R will be used for departures and Runway 15L will be used for arrivals
- Toronto and Mississauga wards directly to the south of the airport will be affected (Toronto 3 & 5, Mississauga 3 & 5)

Runway 15R-33L

Impacts – 33L

- When weather requires operations to the north, Runway 33L is usually assigned to arrivals, and Runway 33R to departures
- As Runway 33L will not have a functioning ILS it will not be assigned to arrivals
- Runway 33L will be used for departures and Runway 33R will be used for arrivals
- Runway 33L departures have been approved to conduct straight out departures to avoid aircraft intersecting in the air should an arrival on Runway 33R overshoot
- Brampton wards directly to the north of the airport will be affected (7, 8, 9 & 10) as well as Mississauga ward 5

Runway 06L-24R

The Work

- In August and September surface maintenance on taxiways and the holding bay area for Runway 06L-24R will be carried out
- The runway itself is not being worked on
 - However, due to the proximity, the runway will be unavailable in compliance with regulations at times

The Impacts

- The expected impact on operations will be a greater number of departures on Runway 06R to the east and Runway 24L to the west
- These runways are located closer to the communities than 06L-24R, therefore their increased use may impact areas south of their flight paths
- Departures on runway 24L will impact areas of Mississauga to the west of the airport (Wards 5, 6 & 11)
- Departures on runway 06R will impact areas of Toronto directly east of the airport (Wards 2, 3 & 4)
