





Restricted Hours Flights (November 2012–October 2013)

## New Commercial Agreement between GTAA and Air Canada

Starting January 1, a new commercial agreement between the GTAA and Air Canada takes effect to further develop Toronto Pearson as a global hub, including continued customer service improvements, greater flight frequencies to existing markets and access to more global destinations.



## **Early Turn Trial**


The trial program allowing early turns on the north/south runways and extended prop turn hours continues.

Throughout the trial so far, from March 3, 2008, to October 31, 2013, 2,304 eligible jet aircraft (19 per cent) conducted an early turn off the north/south runways, resulting in six complaints. During this time, 3,095 props (92 per cent) conducted early turns between the hours of 6:30 and 6:59 a.m., while 5,239 (84 per cent) initiated early turns between 11:01 and 11:30 p.m., resulting in 196 complaints.




Runway Movements and Noise Complaints by Runway Operation (August–October, 2013)
