



Early Turn Trial

Propeller Aircraft Turns	Early Jet Turns		
 Propeller aircraft are permitted to turn to course shortly after takeoff from any runway between the hours of 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. This is standard procedure since the 1970s. 	 Certain small jet aircraft are permitted to turn to course shortly after takeoff on the east/west runways between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. This is standard procedure since 2005. 		
• During the trial, prop turns are also permitted until 11:30 p.m. and from 6:30 a.m.	 During the trial, early turns are also permitted on the north/ south runways. 		
 From March 3, 2008, to July 31, 2015 3,588 props (91%) participated between 6:30 and 6:59 a.m 7,397 props (83%) participated between 11:01 and 11:30 p.m. 	 From March 3, 2008, to July 31, 2015 2,438 eligible jet aircraft (19 per cent) participated. 9 complaints are attributed to this trial.
