- » Being a good neighbour means balancing these diverse and sometimes competing priorities for the constituencies we're in business to serve.







 - Analyze feedback collected during the consultation process
 - Identify which mitigations to implement and timelines
- » Timelines:
 - Winter Spring 2016





Implementation + Monitoring

» Audience:

» Objective:

- Advise on outcomes of consultation and next steps
- Implement noise mitigation
- Monitor and measure to benchmark outcomes
- Report back to community and industry

• Spring 2016 – ongoing




Role of CENAC
